With SMHI, there will be no interruption in coverage as your coverage is continuous and goes into effect May 15 or when your crop is seeded.

To obtain coverage on crops seeded on rented land or to purchase coverage in addition to that available from SMHI, you can get that coverage online with PMHL or by connecting with one of our agents representing AMHL. If cash flow is a concern, the premiums owing for your coverage with SMHI can be deferred to December 31 interest-free.
