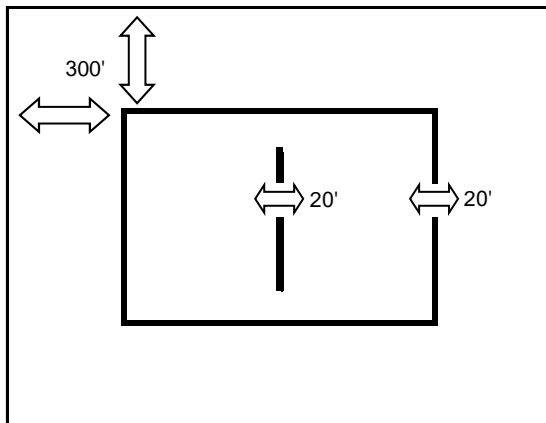


## Harvesting or Turning Crops Under Prior to Inspection for Hail Loss

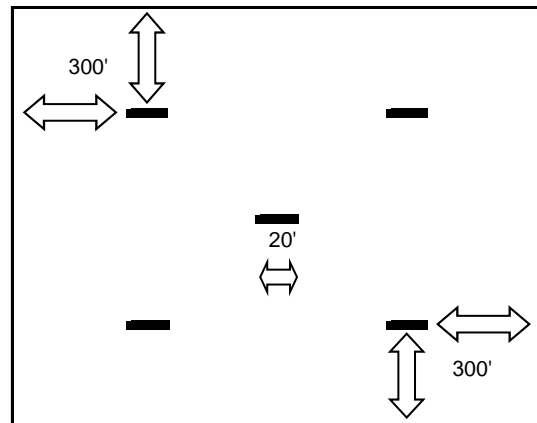
1. Where the crop is being **turned under** or **cut for feed**, leave standing a 12 foot wide strip, 300 feet in from the outside edges of the field, all the way around the field. For fields in **excess** of 80 acres, leave an additional strip down the centre of the field.
2. If the crop is **ready to swath, leave no crop standing**. Swath it all as the adjustment will be made from the swath. **Exception: Leave standing samples of peas and lentils.**
3. Where a **swathed crop is being harvested**, fields in **excess** of 80 acres, leave five 20 foot lengths of swath, one on each corner (300 feet in from edges) and one in the middle of the field. Fields **less** than 80 acres leave three 20 foot lengths of swath, 300 feet in from the edge of the field, one on each end and middle.
4. Where the crop is being **straight combined**, the location of the evidence remains the **same** as stated for swathed crops. The size is the width of the header by 20 feet in length.
5. If a hail claim has been filed and **sufficient undisturbed evidence of the crop has not been left for inspection**, the question of liability will be decided at Head Office.

**Turning under or cutting for feed**



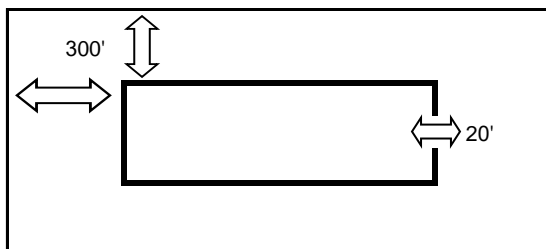
**Over 80 acres**

**Picking up swaths or straight cutting**



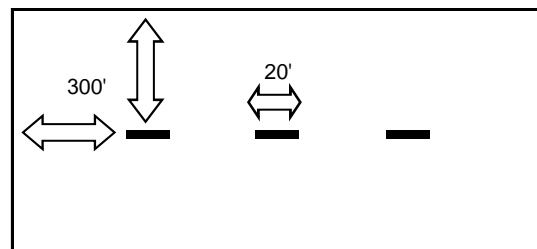
**Over 80 acres**
